

Crawl Key Reverse Osmosis Facility

Florida Keys Aqueduct Authority will construct a new 4 million gallons per day (mgd) seawater reverse osmosis (RO) water treatment plant (WTP) at Crawl Key. This WTP is located in the Middle Keys, thus providing an alternative water source in the event that there is a disruption of service to the main transmission line. This project also increases FCAA's water supply to meet future customer needs. The project will include a new WTP, a 5 million gallon above ground storage tank, and a new pump station to deliver potable water into the existing transmission main system. Construction is expected to be completed in October 2028.
